





Christchurch - Arthur's Pass

Arthur's pass – A National Park located deep in the Southern Alps of New Zealand. You will be traveling on the Great Alpine Highway through the ever-changing remarkable landscapes. This tour highlights an example of great engineering, spectacular waterfalls, and famous filming locations.

The day will begin with a collection from your chosen accommodation before we hit the road towards Arthur's pass, our knowledgeable and friendly guide will point out those stunning views along the way. While on this tour with us you will see a variety of green fields to rugged mountain ranges, lush forest and ice-fed lakes and rivers!

There are plenty of stops along the route, so we won't be spending all day in the van although it is pretty comfy. You can hop on a Jetboat and grab an action thrilled tour of where it all began or walk through the thick forest and check out a waterfall. Of course, we will also stop at those must-see Instagram worthy spots too!

We recommend checking out some of the add-ons available on this trip. There are so many great activities that can be done, and we are more than happy to help you make the most of





- Christchurch We start by leaving the Garden City/Christchurch and heading north towards our destination, while our knowledgeable driver points out some of the Garden City's highlights.
- **Springfield / AlpineJet** As we make our way through the Selwyn District you will be greeted by the Gorgeous little western town of Springfield where we make our turn off towards Alpine Jets. Here you will spend time experiencing the wonders of the Waimakariri, it's no wonder Jet Boating was developed here in Christchurch! For those that have decided to not add this onto their tour, there are walks, views and sheep cuddles to enjoy.
- Castle Hill Once back in the van we head towards Castle Hill. These weathered limestone rocks sit proudly on the tussocky hills and were once in the ocean! Over time they eroded away and started forming these amazing unique shapes you'll see today. You might recognize this landscape from movies such as Lord of the Rings and Narnia! That's right. Not only that, but while you walk amongst the rocks you will also see climbers and boulderers! This place is a magnet for those types of hobbies. This is not a guided walk so you will be left to explore this piece of beauty on your own.
- Otira Gorge Lookout Also known as Deaths Corner! The Otira Viaduct Lookout is an amazing spot to see the national park in all its glory. This bridge is the only reason driving Arthurs Pass is possible! It's huge at 440 Meters long and is a great spot for a photo of the bridge and the surrounding landscape. A little bonus too, you might see a wee Cheeky Kea! The sneaky Alpine Parrot of NZ.
- Arthur's Pass Village We depart the lookout and head towards Arthur's Pass village. On
 the way you will be able to see the beautiful backdrop of the majestic Southern Alps up
 close. Once we arrive you will have the opportunity to either walk the Devils Punch Bowl or
 spend this time walking around the local shop. Here you will also be able to grab lunch.
 - **Devils Punch Bowl** This walking track is approx. I hour with a gradual incline including steps towards a ferocious 131-meter-tall waterfall. Fitness is low to moderate as you walk through the bush and forest.
 - **Arthur's Pass Village** Grab a bite to eat, a coffee and shop some local goodies! This village is a great way to really get to know the area.
- Cave Stream This is formed by the caves stream as it flows through an underground
 passage for 594 meters. This cave can be accessed by inexperienced cavers. Pretty incredible to look at.
- **Christchurch** Sadly we get ready to make our way back to the Garden City! We then take you back to the accommodation where you started your journey from this Morning. All in a day's work aye! Here we officially say our goodbyes but send you off with some great photos and even better memories!






Quad Biking



At 3724m, Aoraki/Mt Cook is home to New Zealand's highest peak and longest glacier – Haupapa/Tasman Glacier. The famous Lake Tekapo and world-renowned meat pies at Fairlie Bakehouse – are the places you will discover or rediscover on this tour, so escape the hustle and bustle of the city life and head out on an adventure to some of the most beautiful parts of the South Island

You will be driven in comfort in our modern, comfortable minibuses packed with extras, just to make your journey that bit easier. Led by our fun and knowledgeable and passionate tour guides, this journey will come to life in a new way for you.





- Christchurch We start by leaving Garden City/Christchurch and heading south towards our destination, while our knowledgeable driver points out some of the Garden City's highlights.
- **Canterbury Plains** Wrapped around Christchurch are the Canterbury Plains filled with farmland as far as the eye can see. Most types of farming you can think of will be found on the plains such as crops, vineyards, dairy and livestock production.
- Fairlie Bakehouse A Classic New Zealand farming town hidden away in Mackenzie. Fairlie
 goes through some stunning colour changes especially come Autum, this is truly one of the
 best locations to sit and relax with one of their world-famous meat Pies from the Bakehouse.
 And this stop is also where we will pick up your lunch to keep you full of energy for the rest of
 the day.
- Lake Tekapo/ Church of the Good Shepherd An alpine lake region like no other in the heart of Mackenzie. At the right time of year, you will find clusters of wild lupins along the lake edge. Once we arrive in Tekapo we head towards the most popular photo spots in the country The Church of The Good Shepard for those social media worthy pictures.
- Lake Pukaki This glacier fed lake is unique compared to its alpine partners. The colours can change from ice blue to a dark deep blue depending on the weather conditions. On a clear day enjoy undisturbed views right up to Mt Cook which appears to extend out of the head of the lake.
- Aoraki/Mt Cook National Park AND HERE WE ARE! Named after the famous explorer James Cook, Aoraki/Mt Cook is New Zealand's highest peak. Once here you will have the choice to embark on either The Hooker Valley or The Tasman Glacier walk. If a flight overlooking the mountains is more your thing, we are happy to arrange Helicopter rides for you and the family to enjoy.
 - **Hooker Valley -** The Hooker valley track is one of the highest rated day walks in New Zealand. It's not hard to see why as you walk alongside an ice-covered cliff face (Listen carefully you may hear it moving) all the way to an ice filled lake with Mt Cook at its end. This walk takes 2.5-3 hours to complete.
 - **Tasman Glacier** This track leads through the glacier's old terminal moraines, and there you will find amazing views of the glacier, river, and lake.
 - Mt Cook Information Centre (DOC) You are more than welcome to take it all in by spending the day in the information centre with a coffee. Learn the history of the national park, ask questions and just be in moment.
- **Lake Tekapo** We stop briefly in Lake Tekapo for one last time to take those last minute late evening photos of the Church and the Lake.
- **Christchurch** After what has been a simply beautiful day, we will head back to the Garden City. Its bittersweet as you'll be exhausted but filled with new memories. Please note additional stops are taken into considerations for toilet breaks.



Day Tour - Mt Hutt

The mountain is calling. Just over 1 hour drive from Christchurch lies Mt Hutt Village Methven. This once quiet rural village town is now known around the world by sport lovers and skiers, and each year thousands of visitors from around the world base themselves here at the heart of seven ski areas and over 1000 square kilometers of the best Heli-skiing terrain in New Zealand. To top it all off, why not soak up the views from the highest altitude spa in New Zealand! Sitting on top of Mt Hutt, and accessible from the Summit Six Chairlift, there is an alpine spa pool that has all the bells and whistles – how cool is that! So, sit back and soak it all up.

Mt Hutt has been voted New Zealand's best ski resort for seven years running at the World Ski Awards.
